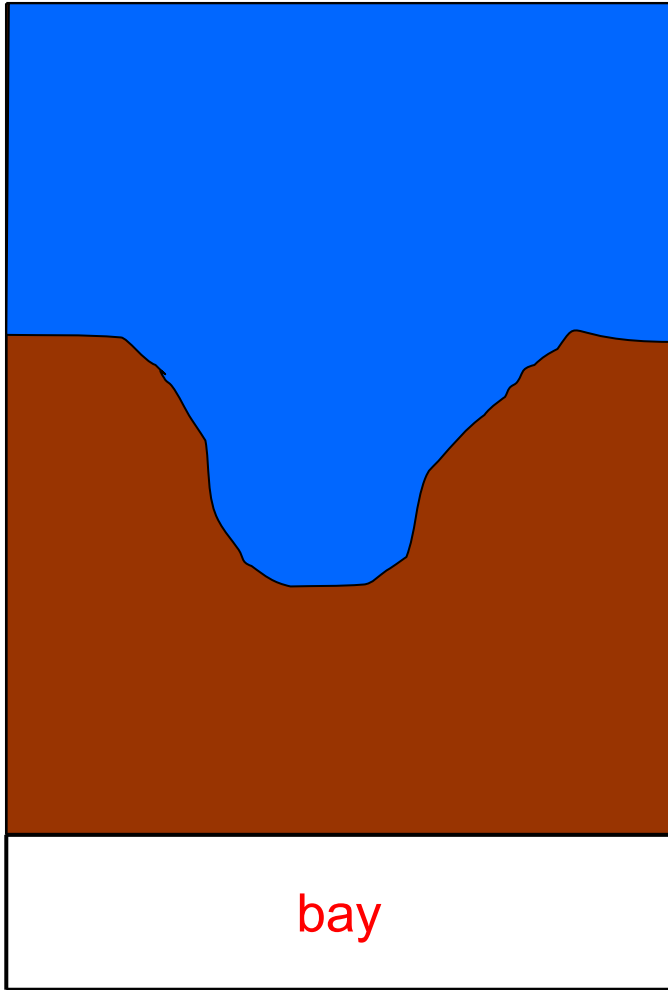


cape

A **cape** is a pointed piece of land that sticks out into an ocean, sea, lake or river.

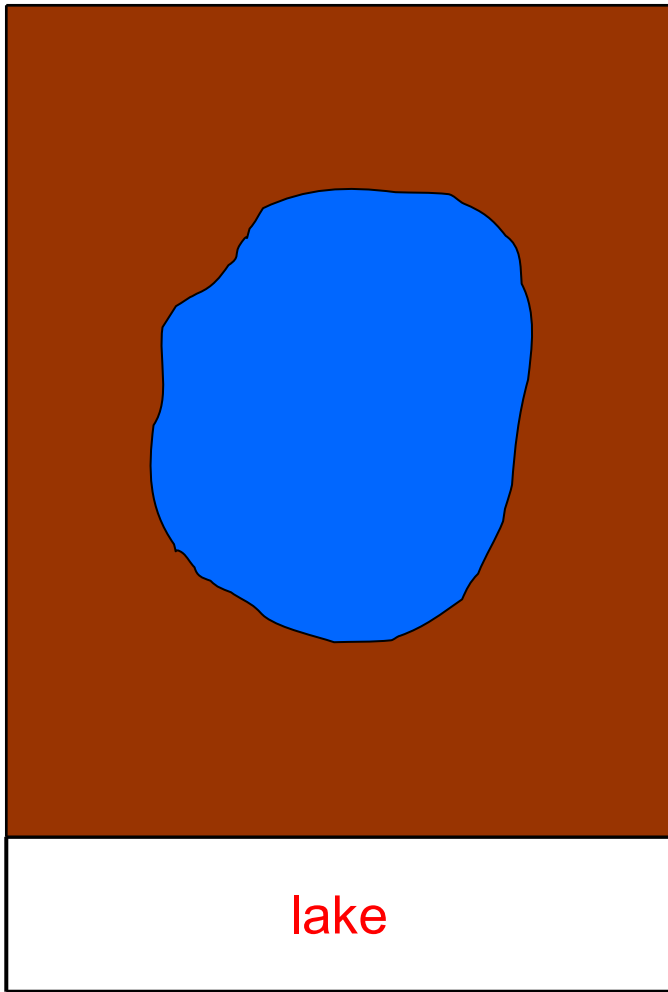

A bay is when part of the sea or river reaches into the land.

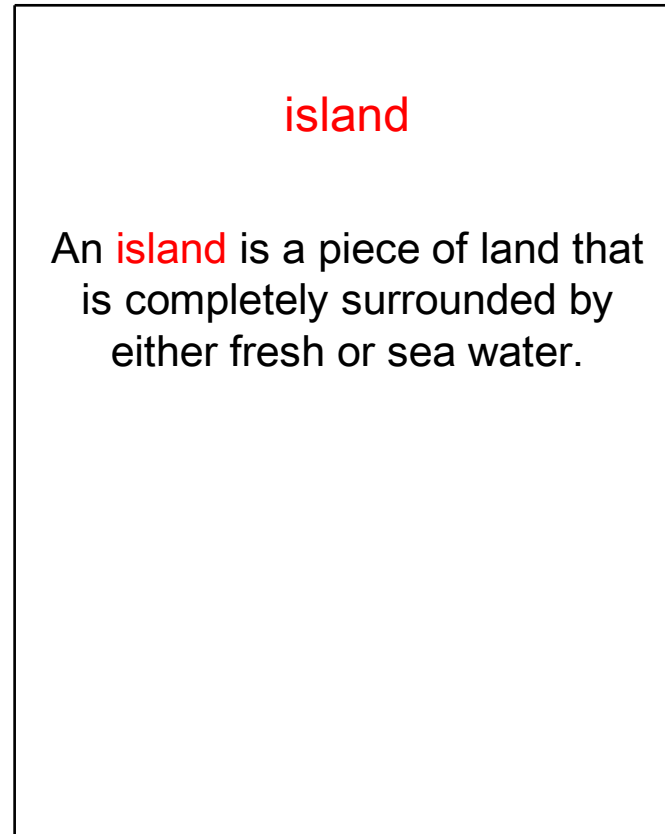
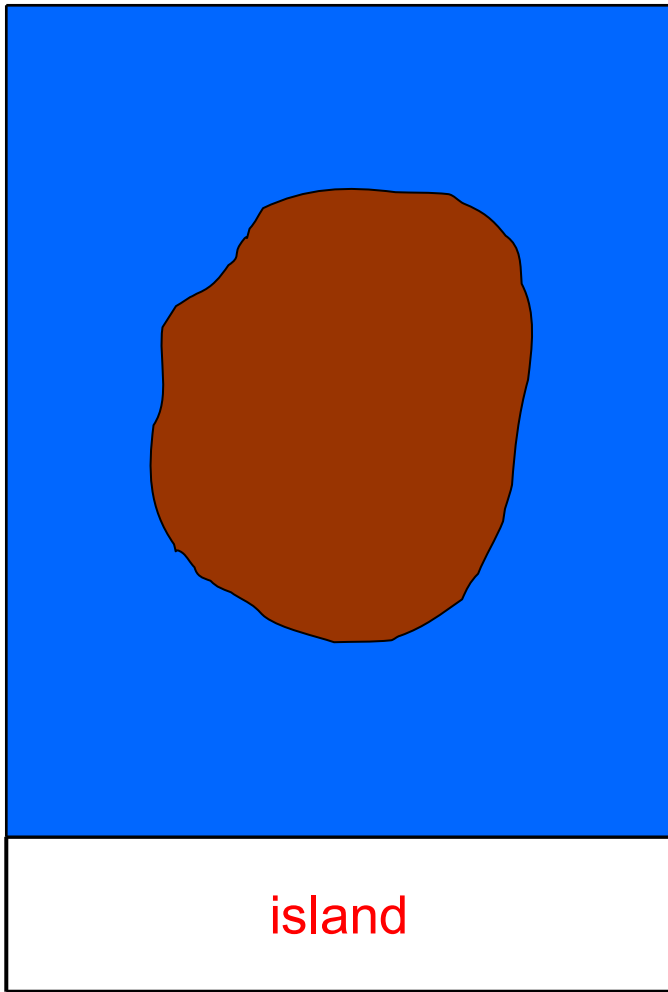

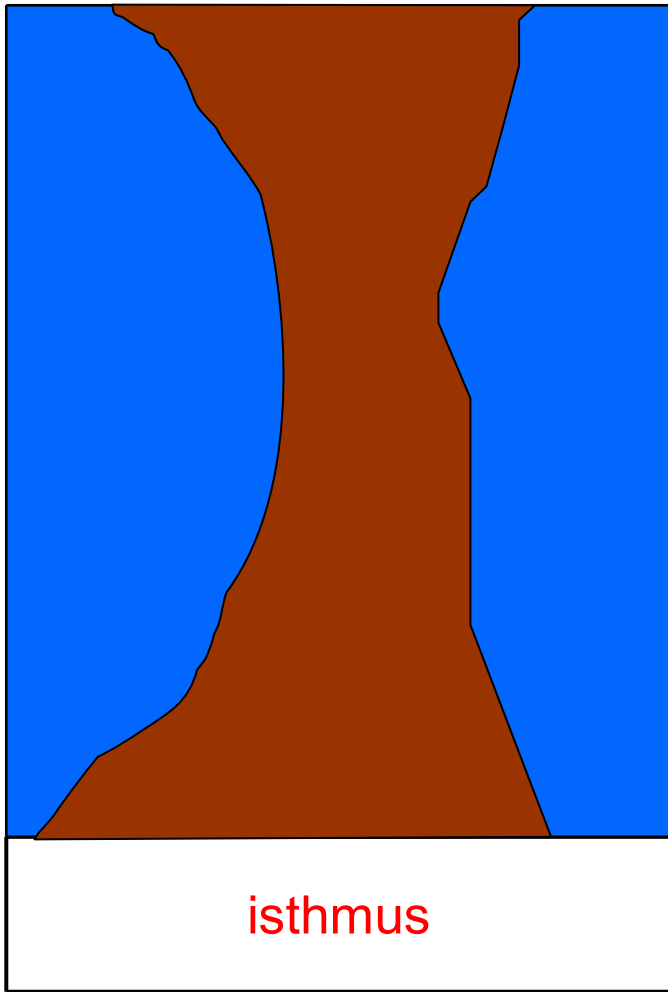


lake

lake

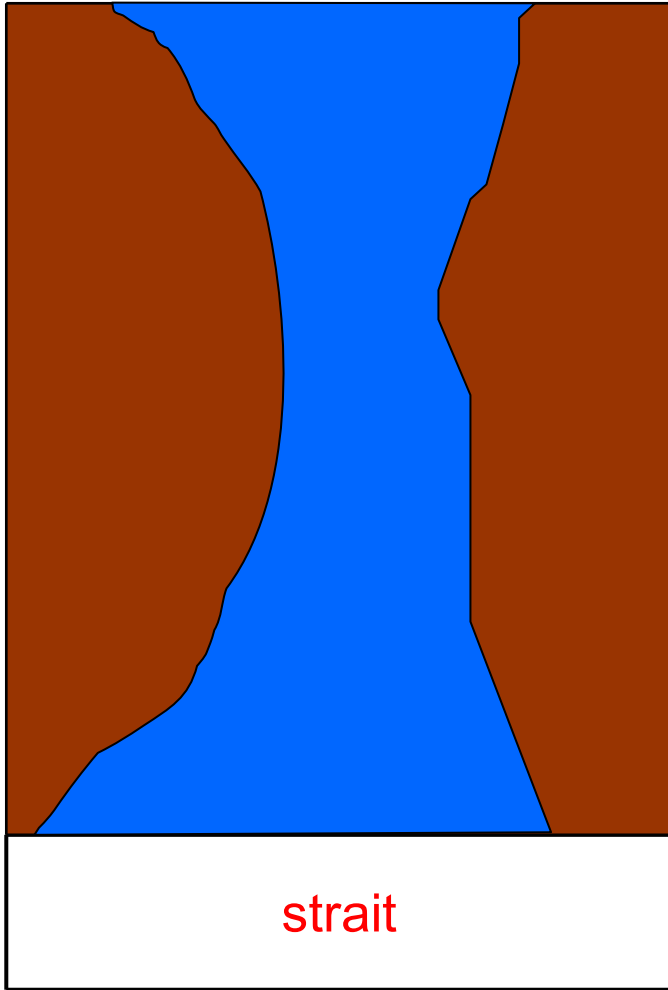




isthmus

An **isthmus** is a narrow piece of land connecting two larger pieces of land at each end that is surrounded on both sides by water.

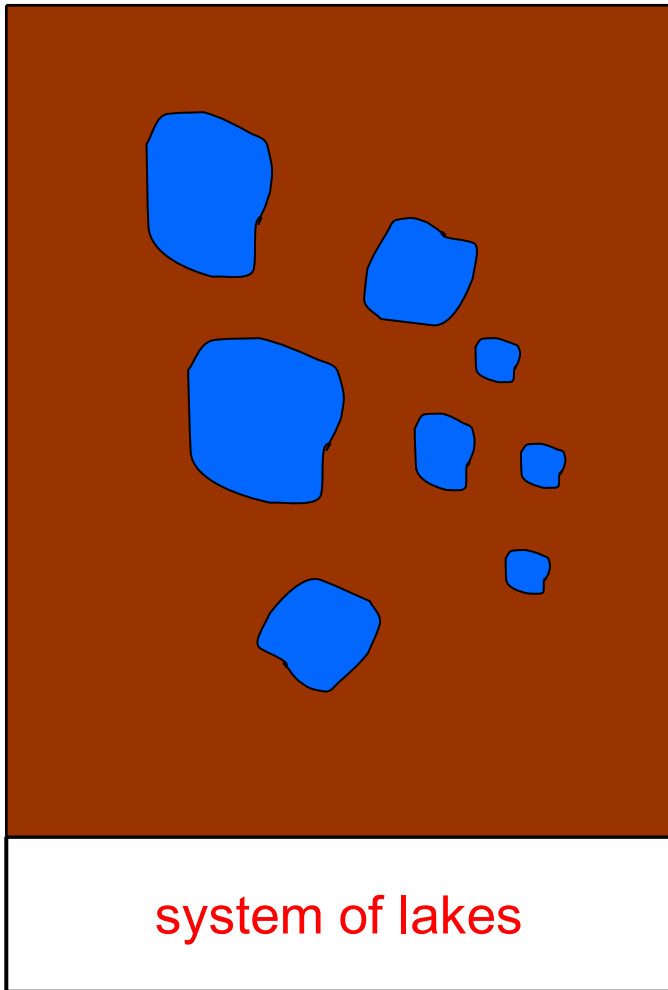

A **strait** is a narrow passageway of water connected to two larger bodies of water at each end.

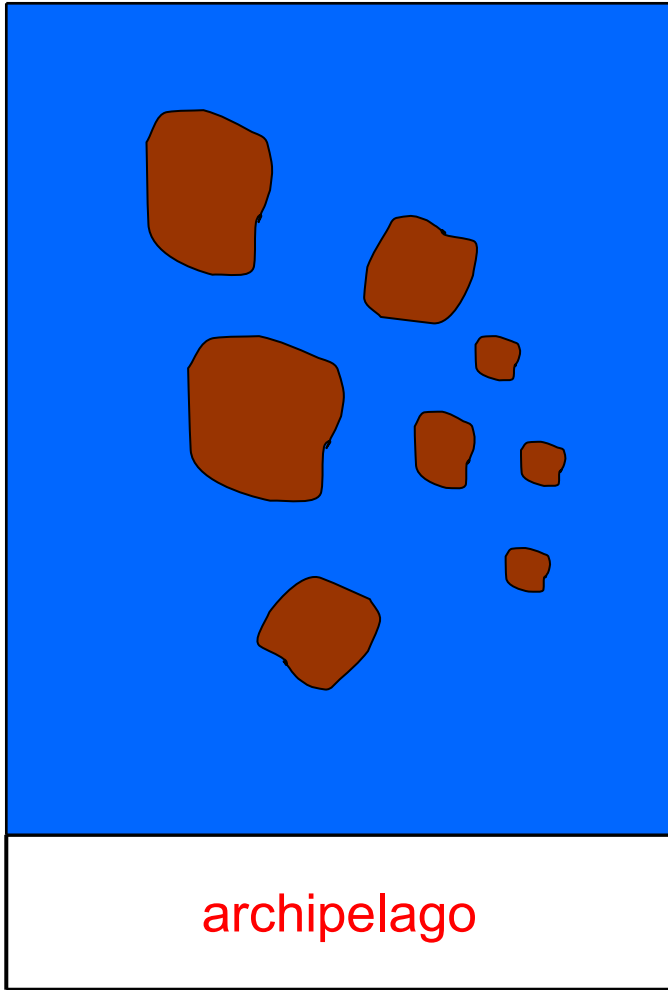

A **system of lakes** is a group of lakes in the same area usually containing fresh water.

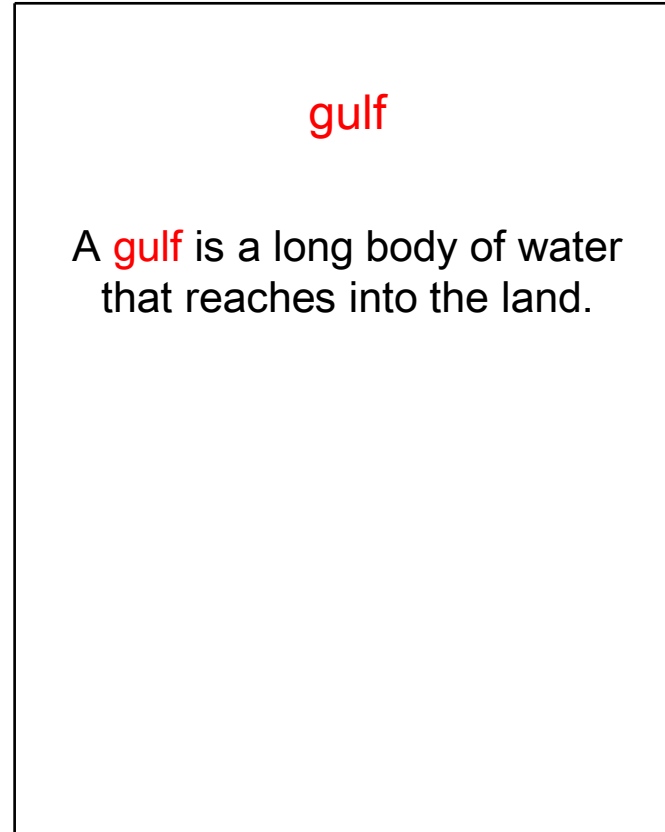
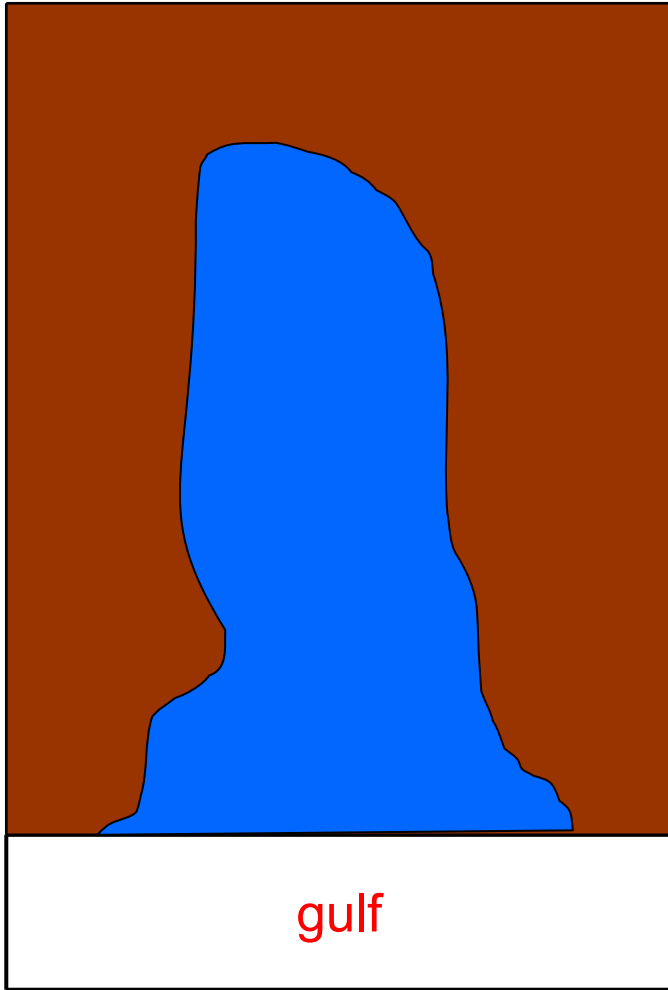

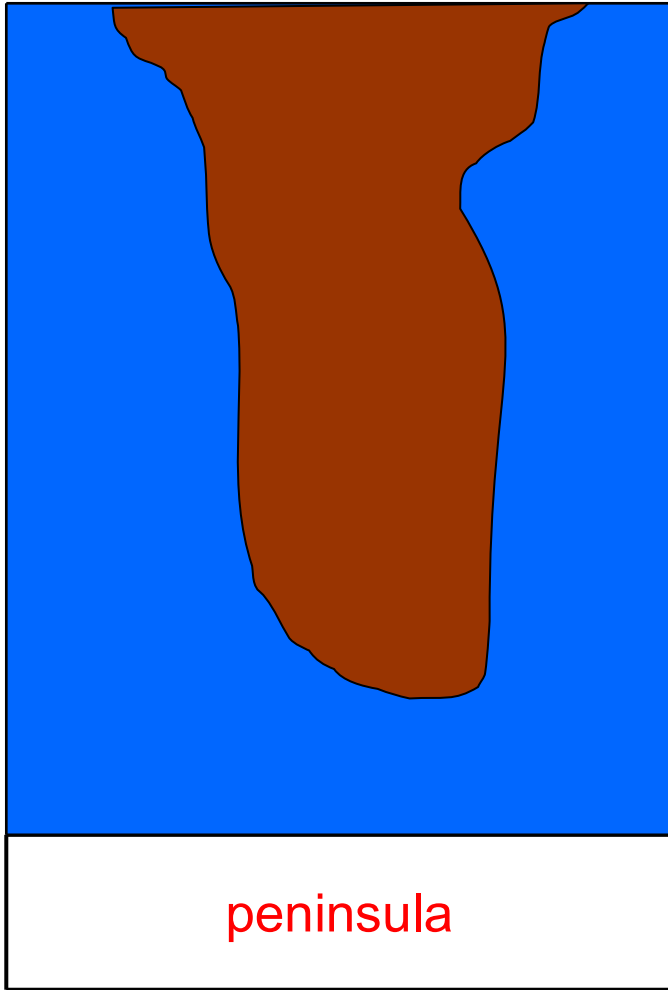


archipelago
